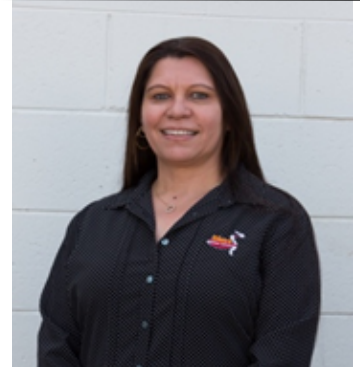

FAR NORTH TRAFFIC ALLIANCE

Hello everyone, I am excited to give you all an update on our traffic business.

We are still in our first year of operation and going strong for such a young business with the solid groundwork for success being laid well before the first pair of boots hit the ground.

Our most consistent works to date have been providing the traffic management for the Joy Baluch Bridge project, the work has been a combination of lane closures, pedestrian control, crane & truck movements and gate work all performed through rain, hail or shine over any time of the day or night and weekends. We also provide after-hours site safety checks even through the recent lockdown.

Since starting on the bridge in November 2020 we have secured another three clients with a fourth (BHP) due to start in August and the fifth not far behind. The work we are now doing has been from Port Lincoln to Port Wakefield it has been wide and varied and requires long hours from the team and a number of nights away from home so well done to all involved.

Given all of the work in the pipeline we are now entering the next stage of our development which requires a person to assist with the daily requirements of coordinating the team and our fleet.

We hope you and your family stayed safe and well during this period.

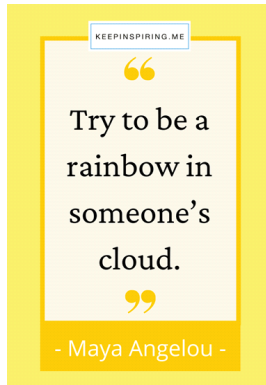

11 Ingredients:

- 2 tbsp olive oil
- 1 onion, finely chopped
- 1 leek, white part only, finely sliced
- 1 garlic clove, crushed
- ½ tsp ground coriander
- 1 tsp ground cumin
- ½ tsp freshly grated nutmeg
- 1 kg peeled pumpkin, diced
- 1 large potato, peeled, diced
- 1L Chicken or Vegetable liquid stock
- ½ cup (125ml) cream



2 Method Steps:

Step 1 - Heat oil in large saucepan over low heat, add onion and leek and cook for 2 - 3 minutes, until softened. Add garlic and spices and cook, stirring, for 30 seconds. Add pumpkin, potato and stock and bring to the boil. Turn heat to low, cover and simmer for 30 minutes. Allow to cool slightly, then blend in batches.

Step 2 - Return soup to pan, stir through cream and reheat gently. Season and add a little more nutmeg if desired.
